

**ED2CC** offers students the opportunity to gain authentic workplace experience in the civil construction field. Students complete a certificate qualification while gaining practical baseline skills and experience in the field.

Located onsite at McCosker Contracting **ED2CC** provides an alternative education pathway for Year 10 students from Gladstone SHS, Toolooa SHS, and Tannum Sands SHS who want to gain baseline skills and experience in the civil construction field. Students are on-site one day per week from 7.30am to 3.00pm working with a variety of mentors at McCosker Contracting to perform real tasks in real contracting situations. Year 10 students remain enrolled at their base school and attend the program 1 day per week. Students commit to two week's approved work experience with McCosker Contracting.

### Career Development Program

### Application and Selection Process

EQIP undertake a rigorous and consistent recruitment and selection process to ensure that our students are the best fit for the program. When submitting the 'Expression of Interest' form, please attach a current student resume, teacher references and the latest report card. While it is recommended that students have a pass in Maths and English, other factors are taken into account such as behaviour and previous work experience.
