

ED2CC offers students the opportunity to gain authentic workplace experience in the civil construction field. Students complete a certificate qualification while gaining practical baseline skills and experience in the field.

Located onsite at McCosker Contracting **ED2CC** provides an employability skill development opportunity in the civil construction field for year 10 students from Gladstone SHS, Toolooa SHS, Tannum Sands SHS, Mount Larcom SS, and Miriam Vale SS. Students are onsite one day per week during industry operating hours (7am to 3pm) working with a variety of mentors at McCoskers to perform projects and activities in real work situations. Year 10 students remain enrolled at their base school and complete the program as one of your school subjects. Note: Tannum Sands SHS and Toolooa SHS students complete the program as an *additional* subject.

Upon successful completion of all units in the course, students will be issued with a certificate. Should a student not complete the entire course then a Statement of Attainment will be given for the units successfully completed.

EXPERIENCE Students complete 2 x 1 week blocks of structured work experience with McCoskers, and group tour experiences.

SKILLS Students participate in the EQIP Career Development Program to build personal brand, learn about behavioural skills that employers are looking for, and navigate recruitment and selection processes.

Students are also provided information and support on progression into an EQIP senior program.

Application and Selection Process

EQIP undertake a rigorous and consistent recruitment and selection process to ensure that students are the best fit for the program. When submitting the 'Expression of Interest' form, attach a student resume, 2 teacher references and the latest report card. Offers will be made in term 4 of the current school year for the next year intake.

Students must have a Queensland Construction Induction (White Card) in order to be accepted into the program.

Costs

Program student levies are reviewed on an annual basis to ensure that the fees are reasonable and can recover a portion of the costs that are incurred through delivery of EQIP Programs on campus or off-site at our specialised learning facilities.
