

**PREQIP** is an individualised Career Development and Case Management model for Year 10 indigenous students to investigate and be counselled around potential career opportunities in the region.



## What will students do?

Students will undergo a personal evaluation report and associated career investigation (information, opportunities and pathways) that will inform their set plan. Students brought on as part of the program will be offered training, mentoring, work experience and other opportunities to assist them in aligning with their chosen career pathway to a university course, apprenticeship, traineeship or full-time employment.

### Create opportunities and pathways



- Participate in Career Investigation and Counselling
- Be offered funded short-course training (White Card, First Aid)
- Opportunities to attend organised industry site visits aligned to their identified SET Planning Career Interests.
- Receive Academic coaching and tracking around school assessments and results.
- Opportunity to visit EQIP Senior Programs and guidance on application process.
- Receive Career Development support and training
- Speak to current Apprentices, Trainees and Workers in areas of interest.
- Undertake Work experience with local host employer/s to demonstrate and develop employability skills.

### Location



Enrolled school, EQIP Technical College and/or varied locations in the Gladstone area.

### Duration



The program will run through Term 3 and 4 of 2020. Students may opt into activities that interest them – around their school studies

### Cost



All costs associated with this program are funded by our program partners

### 2020 Enrolment



Applications for the 2020 Pilot Program are currently open to eligible students through part of their SET Planning process.



## What are the pathways?

Our goal is for PREQIP students to remain in school continue on a pathway aligned to their individual career goals. This may include a senior EQIP program, University course, apprenticeship, traineeship or full-time employment in the Gladstone Region.



## Application and selection process

EQIP undertake a rigorous and consistent recruitment and selection process to ensure that our students are the best fit for the program. Suitability for the program will be assessed with Senior Schooling Departments during SET Plan meetings and applications completed with the student and their families to submit to EQIP.



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
